A Chat with Our New Home

Here they come with my new sign – The Forestry Building. What an exciting day! Carpenters are busy building new labs and remodeling and by spring I should be all done. I can't wait! Already students are attending classes inside. I heard some students talking, laughing, drinking coffee and eating donuts in their new lounge on my first floor. The students seem proud to have a building of their own and the faculty enjoy the convenience of being together.

I remember when it all began. Back in the 1900's, Congress passed a bill to promote agricultural experimentation. The Purdue Agricultural Experiment Station Building was built – now known as Agricultural Administration – to carry out this purpose. This was such a large task that a temporary structure was constructed to take up the overflow – (that's me!) In November of 1911 I was badly damaged in a storm. Soon after, I was made into a two-story brick building with a tile roof. At this time I was called a Seed House because scientists did seed experiments inside of me. Those were the good old days when there was a great rivalry between the agriculture students and the engineers.

Nineteen twenty-five was a year for big changes. The Union was built as a memorial to the men who died in World War 1, the Horticulture Building was built and Ross-Ade Stadium was opened. I also received a face-lift. I became a three-story building with a two-story wing. At about this time I acquired a new name – the Agricultural Experiment Station Annex – which was converted simply to Ag. Annex I.

With this new addition, things began to change. In 1930, the U.S. Dept. of Agricultural Extension moved in. The Extension Service provided farmers with information about the current developments in the field of agriculture. In the forties, the Entomology Department flew in with their large insect collections – I still feel a little buggy. Then in 1950 Ag. Econ. moved in too. Boy, was I crowded. When the Entomology Building and the Krannert Building came into being, everyone bugged out. After they moved, the Navy ROTC sailed in. Soon after, the first forestry professor cruised in.

By the summer of 1976 most of the staff had moved in. Before the move was complete Dr. Fred Montague made headlines with the Office of Student Services. The OSS provides the students with all types of counseling services from class scheduling to job information.

The faculty here at the School of Forestry tries to provide the students with all the services they need. Even with such a large group of students the faculty tries to give individual attention. The students are so friendly and eager to learn and the staff is the best in the country. I feel proud to be "the foundation of the School of Forestry here at Purdue. With my recent changes I hope I can provide the staff and the students with a new home.



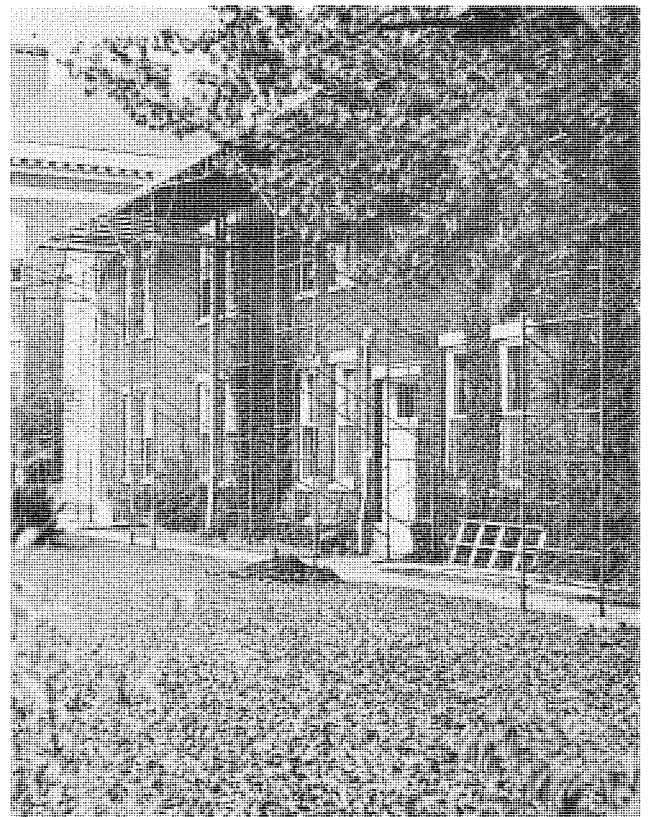
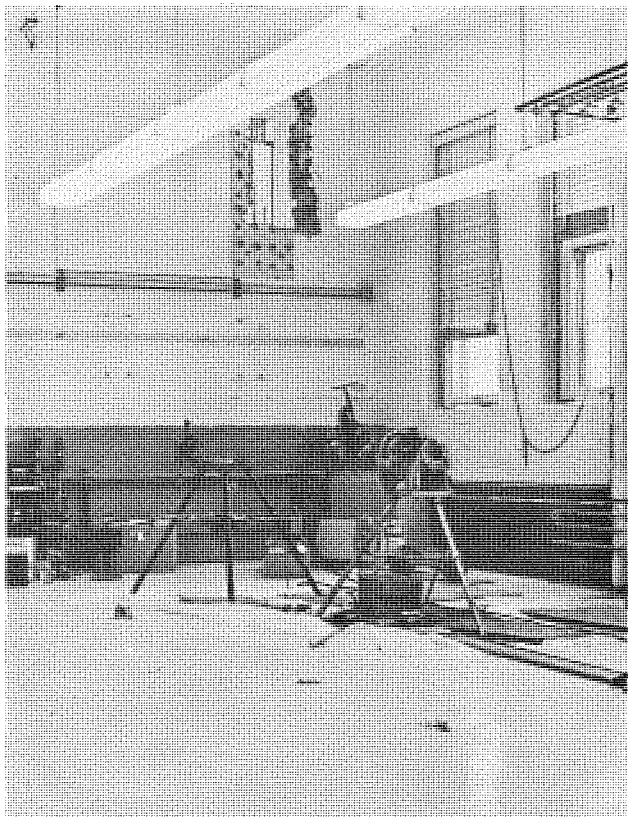

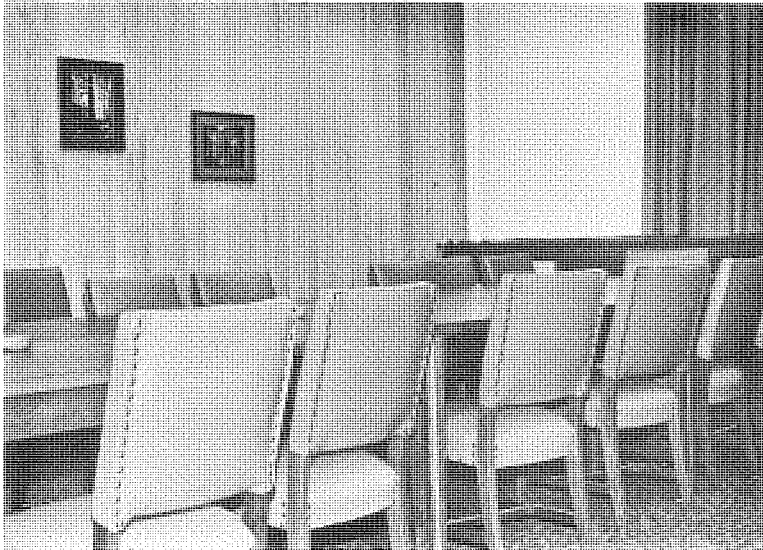


The Seed House, around 1911 (left).

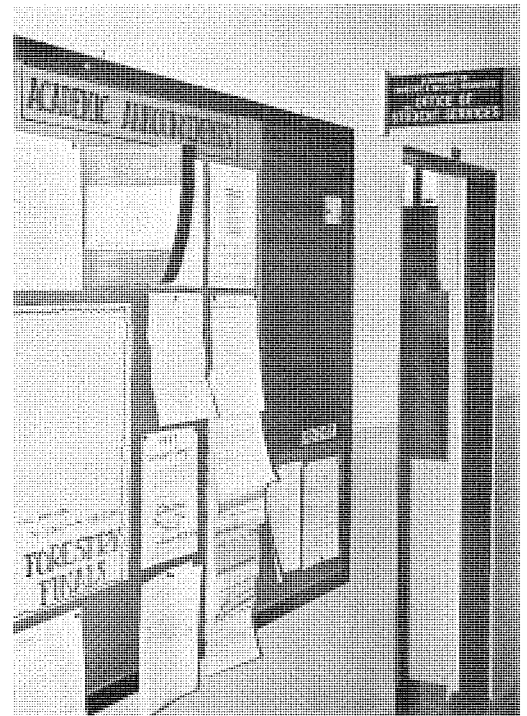

SPECIAL AWARDS

Frank F. Ballintyn, a junior in forestry at Purdue University, has won second place in the second annual Northeastern Loggers' Association essay contest which is open to all juniors in forestry schools in the eastern United States. A cash prize of \$500 went to Mr. Ballintyn who wrote a 1500 word essay on "The Coming Age of Wood."

This contest is designed to aid deserving students planning careers in forestry. The Northeastern Loggers' Association, which conducted the contest, is comprised of members from all phases of the forest industry in the 25 state area which is designated the Northern Region by the U. S. Forest Service. A panel of distinguished judges selected the winners.

FEDERAL LAND BANK SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS

Each year since 1970, the Indiana Federation of the Federal Land Bank Association, in conjunction with the Purdue Agriculture Alumni Association awards four cash scholarships to the outstanding freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior in the School of Agriculture at Purdue. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of the highest grade point index, and an interview with the Scholarship Committee of the Federal Land Bank Association.

This year, the Department of Forestry and Natural Resources is pleased to have among its ranks Mary Clawson (Outstanding Senior Scholarship Recipient) and Tom Bodell (Outstanding Sophomore Scholarship Recipient.) Both were chosen from a group of twelve qualified students to receive the coveted awards.

Academic year 1976-77 was one of problems and progress for the Department of Forestry and Natural Resources. During the year we achieved one milestone in the history of our Department when we moved the administrative offices and most of the faculty into the "new" Forestry Building. Our Building, formerly known as Agriculture Annex 1, is not new by any stretch of the imagination, except to us. But it does mean that for the first time since the Department was formed in 1928, we now have a Building named for the Department that is home to us and no one else.

We do have more of our staff together than ever before, the only classes in our Building are forestry classes, we are able to provide a very small, but highly appreciated student lounge, and we are quite glad we could make the move. The Building needs extensive renovations, which will no doubt take several years to complete, but we have begun the process with the development of several research laboratories on the first floor. The forest industry of the State has been quite generous in donating some fine Indiana hardwood paneling and hardwood furniture, which has helped to make administrative offices quite attractive. We still have a long way to go to solve our space problem, but as mentioned above, we are making progress.

On November 18, 1976, we signed the final papers for the acquisition of the Branchville Civilian Con-

servation Center in Perry County, Indiana. This facility, with dormitory space for 160 students, consists of a class room building, dining room, gymnasium, administrative building, and four faculty residences. We have acquired title to the buildings under a 10-year purchase agreement, and have a permit from the Hoosier National Forest for approximately thirty acres of land on which the buildings are located. We hope to hold the first session of summer camp at the new location in May 1977, at which time we are expecting 120 students.

The undergraduate programs of the Department continues to be popular with incoming students. Overall, enrollment is up slightly this year, but is showing sign of reaching a peak. The programs leading to the B.S.F. degree are increasingly popular, while there is a marked decline in the wildlife science and recreation resources programs. We have not decided what to do with our high enrollments. We are beyond our capacity to offer the quality education that we would like our students to have. But enrollment limitations and quotas are extremely difficult to administer, especially for a single unit within a School or Institution that does not have a general enrollment ceiling.

Charlie Miller and Fred Montague, together with several of our alumni here in the state, have formed a Forestry and Natural Resources Chapter of the

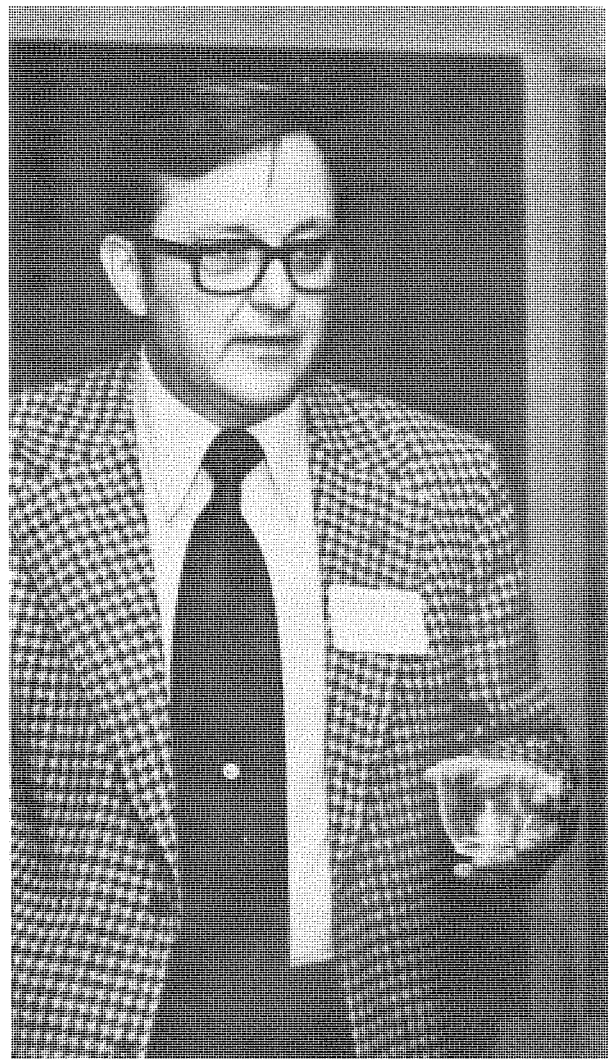
Ag Alumni Association, and are well underway to organizing an effective group. Most of you will be hearing more from this group in the future.

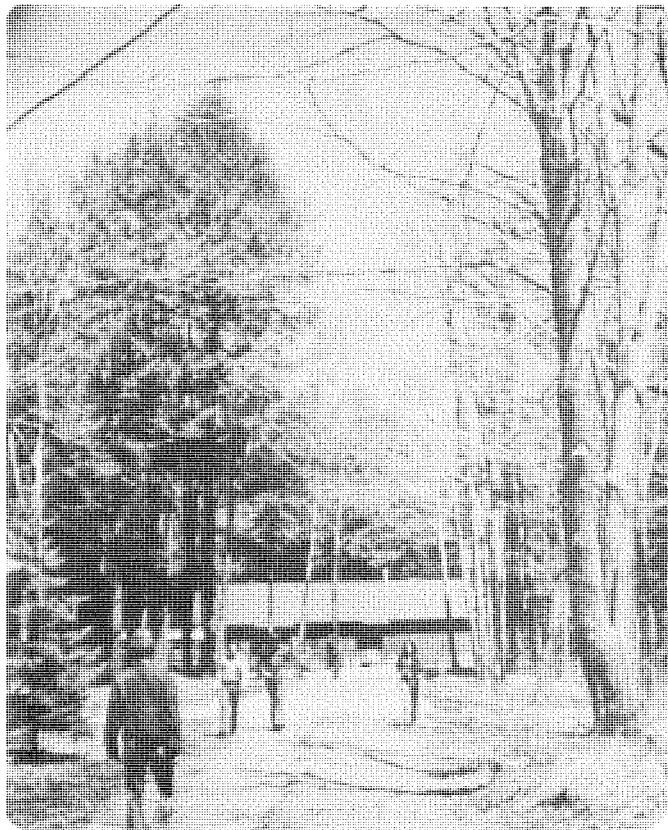
Last spring we had several retirements from the faculty. Durward Allen in wildlife ecology, Eric Stark from wood sciences and Ed Lott, extension forester, retired after long and dedicated service to the University here on the faculty. Mr. Newt Liming, extension forester down at Versailles, Indiana, also retired. We will miss these four gentlemen, but they are in quite good health and active and we hope to continue to see them and to call upon their service and counsel from time to time.

Faculty retirements plus a new position made possible by the administration has permitted us to add several new faces to the faculty. Dr. George Libey, who holds a Ph.D. in fisheries science from the University of Massachusetts, joined the faculty on September 1st and will be teaching courses in vertebrate population dynamics and doing research in fisheries management. Dr. Phillip Pope, Ph.D. in forestry from Virginia Polytechnic Institute, has accepted appointment beginning January 1, 1977, with responsibilities in silviculture research. Dr. Dan Cassens, Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin, will be joining us in March 1977 in an extension position in marketing and wood utilization. We are still seeking to fill a vacancy in extension with an individual who's specialty is silviculture and forest management.

So I think you can see that while we have a number of problems facing us, the Department is making progress and improvement toward better serving our students, our resource, our State and our Alumni, I would still like to hear from and meet more of you, so please write or stop by whenever the opportunity presents itself.

1976 SUMMER CAMP . . . THE CLOSING OF AN ERA

Good-by Lost Lake, forever. There will be no more Purdue forestry camps on your shores. There will be no more Purdue foresters to canoe in your waters, to fathom the depth of your mysterious bottom, or to listen to the loons on your surface laughing at the night. This summer reunion of Purdue foresters, annual since 1959, has finally come to an end.

May 10, 1976 marked the start of the last session at Lost Lake, located in the Nicolet National Forest in northern Wisconsin. Some people arrived by car, some by bus, others by motorcycle, and one by taxi! Everyone was ready with books, paper, pencils, and other supplies for six weeks of forestry classes.

With a biltmore stick in one hand and a diameter tape in the other, Bill Bull queried, "So ya wanna be a forester, eh?" This might have been asked of several people when the going got rough. It might have been asked while being eaten by mosquitoes on field trips, while burning midnight oil trying to finish an exercise due the next day, or while cramming down a sack lunch out of sheer hunger. The question may have first been raised sarcastically, but it allowed for serious contemplation.

During the three trying weeks of mensuration we were exposed to many pieces of technical equipment such as the topo trailer tape, the abney level, Haga altimeter, increment borer, and many others. Dr. Moser's demonstration of the use of the increment borer in class on a decaying white birch looked very simple. However, it was not very simple when boring healthy sugar maples and ironwoods while being "bored" by countless mosquitoes on the Goodman Tract. The industry tours with Dr. Eckelman allowed for a close-up look at the various processes of the paper and sawmill industries. As Dr. Eckelman talked into his tape recorder, we took notes and asked intelligent pertinent questions, such as "how much water does that water tank hold?" After a sack lunch and an untold number of miles on the bus, who could have been ready for a "rehash"? During the week for Ecology and Wildlife we scrutinized various xeric, mesic and hydric sites to study the plants and wildlife on these areas. Just because there were no grouse in the whole survey area does not mean it wasn't grouse habitat. The last week of camp was reserved for silviculture and forest soils. Dr. Merritt embedded the definition of silviculture into our minds while Dr. Byrnes explained the distinction between soil and dirt.

I can still remember the day of the grouse survey. In the morning, while everyone was groggy-eyed and still pumping coffee in their systems, Mickey Weeks previewed the survey. He told us to follow a sample line through a mapped area, and listen for grouse drumming or flushing. Then, count the number of grouse seen or heard, and record the direction of take-off. In the afternoon, the bus dropped us off in groups of four alongside the sample area. Little did we know that we were like WWII paratroopers being dropped off over

Germany. Our sample lines extended through a forest, but then, went straight down into a spagnum moss swamp. Eventually, we reached the road where we were to be picked up. When we pooled our surveys together, a grand total of one grouse had been heard. Dissension was in the air.

The last camp session at Lost Lake created memorable events for everyone, such as the presentation of Jeff Clark's twenty-first birthday cake, Kent Jenkins shampooing his hair with his hard hat on, Mike Ostrowski hunting deer with his car, or was it a deer hunting Mike's car, and Tim Asperry getting "lost" while Joe O'Leary grew grey hairs. Who can forget Fred Rossbach's campaign for the "camper of the year" award marked by the slogan, "Like a . . .don't be red; vote for Fred!" Did the cooks really steal the silverware? How successful was Lance with romance? Why did some people seem to get all the mail? Was it true that Hoosiers have an accent or was it the people in Wisconsin who talked funny?

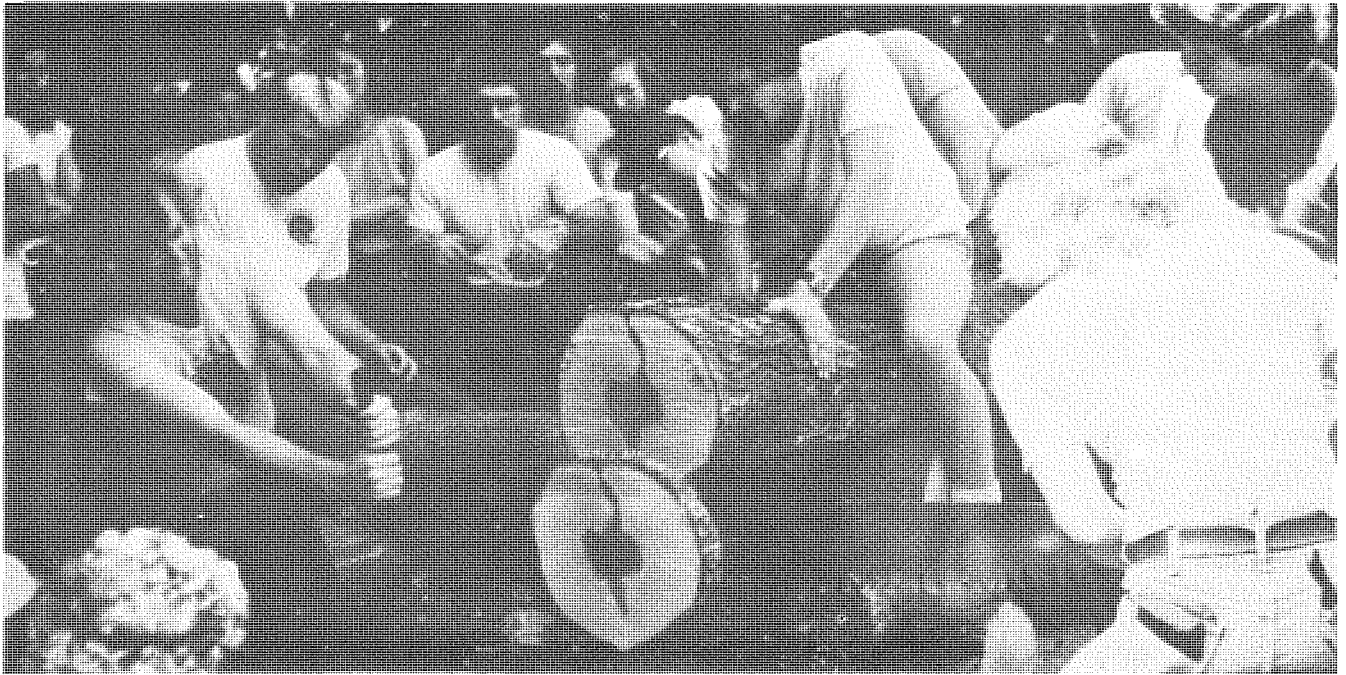
Even though the last camp session in Wisconsin was finished in June of '76, the memories of all the summers, short and long, of many years of Purdue foresters will live on.

WHAT AN EXPERIENCE

Editors note: Every summer students try to find jobs that relate to their major and will help them in the quest for permanent employment. Here are two experiences that FNR students had on the job in the summer of '76

Janet Robbins, a junior in Forest Recreation, spent her '76 summer at Versailles State Park, Indiana as a gate attendant.

What were your responsibilities?

Mostly, I was involved with public relations. I collected boat fees and annual passes as people drove into the park.

What were the benefits of your job?

I could come into the park with a guest without paying. The boat rental was free but I was charged for camping.

My salary this past summer was approximately \$3.10 per hour and I worked 40 hours a week on a varied shift.

How did you get the job?

I've lived near the park all my life so I knew the area in and about the park. Actually getting approved for the job was sort of complicated. First, I talked to the county chairman about the position and he then spoke to the manager of the park. The county chairman set me up with an interview with the park manager. After talking with me, the manager decided he wanted me to work in the park so I filled out some forms for approval. I had to take these papers to four county officials to sign and then the forms were sent to Indianapolis to be approved. Finally, I got word that I was hired. As a result of all this, two percent of my paycheck went to the ruling party in Indiana.

What kind of experience did the position give you in relation to your field?

Mainly I learned how to handle people better and how to handle myself. I encountered people from all over the country and from several foreign countries too. I had to listen to criticisms of the park and explain why policies were the way they were.

Did you have any unique experience on the job?

Well, once I had a man arrested for speeding around a blind curve in the park. Also, I was on duty on a stormy night and a tornado was coming in our direction. My lights went out, but nothing else happened.

Bob Billiter, Senior, Forest Production. Bob has worked the last two summers at Mississinewa State Reservoir near Peru, Indiana.

What did your job involve?

I was a laborer. My job included various maintenance jobs such as mowing and trimming with lawn mowers and weed whips, hauling garbage, trimming trees in campground, clean restrooms, and any other duties that needed done to help in the upkeep of the property.

How did you find out about the position opening?

Well, first I had asked the County Conservation Officer if he knew of any job openings and he referred me to the Indiana Department of Natural Resources. However, you may like to know that the place to apply for a job like this is at the state property itself.

So, what did you have to do to get the job?

I had to obtain patronage clearance forms from the property which had to be signed by county officers.

Was this a difficulty?

It wasn't difficult but it was time consuming because it was hard to catch the officers at home.

For anyone not familiar with patronage, could you describe what it involves?

When you work for Indiana's government as a laborer, you must join the "Two-Percent Club." Basically, this involves paying two percent of every pay check to the party in power. Failure to cooperate may result in not being cleared by the county political officers the next summer if you want to get back on at that property.

Was this job related to your field of study?

Well, yes, in a way. I wanted to get into a natural resource oriented profession and a state reservoir sounded like what I wanted. Although the position I held was not quite forest production related, I feel the managerial experience will undoubtedly help me to some degree in the future. Also I was impressed by the influence of recreation on state properties and the multiple use concept which was practiced to an extent there.

Last but not least, most students looking for a summer job are interested in salaries and working conditions. How well did your job meet these interests?

For the most part, working conditions were good. Sometimes I was required to work night shifts on busy weekends, but other than that it was alright. Pay on state properties are pretty well the same. I made \$3.11 an hour.

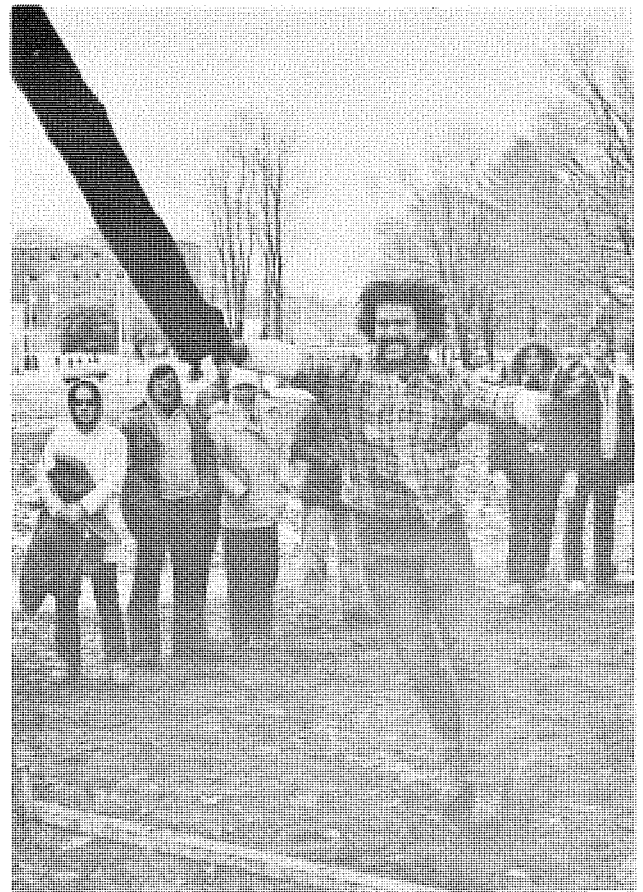
FORESTRY CLUB

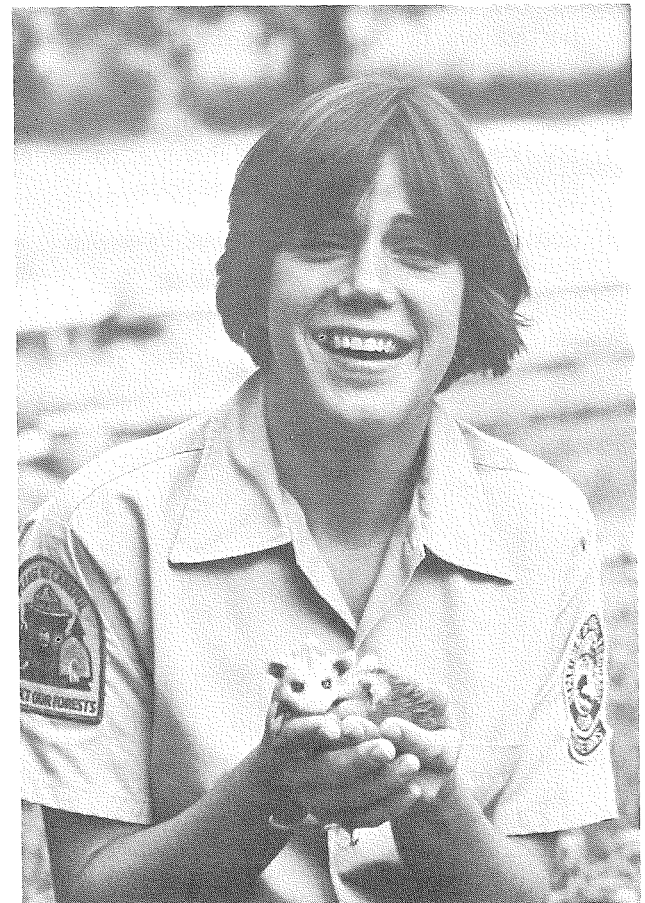

COMMUNITY PROJECTS PROVIDE EXPERIENCE

Purdue's Conservation Club provided its members with valuable experience relating to their careers during the first semester (1976-77). Under the leadership of President Carol Kounanis, Vice-President Janet Robbins, Secretary-Treasurer Cathy Wagner, Publicity Chairman Barb Koth, and Faculty Advisor Professor D. M. Knudson, the group participated in three main activities; Westwood Guides, Nature Preserve Maintenance, and Tippecanoe Guides.

Volunteers for Westwood Guides were supervised by Sue Walters. These students lead area school children and community groups on interpretive nature hikes through Stewart Woods.

Jim Knox directed the maintenance of the Fall Creek Gorge Nature Preserve, thirty miles from campus. The preserve is 40 acres of land owned by the Nature Conservancy, but is locally administered. The main attraction at the preserve is the potholes cut from the limestone walls of the gorge.

Another group conducted living history programs, nature walks, and history hikes at the Tippecanoe Battlefield in Battleground. Gail Wolfrey, chairman of the committee, organized a training session for the guides at Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore.

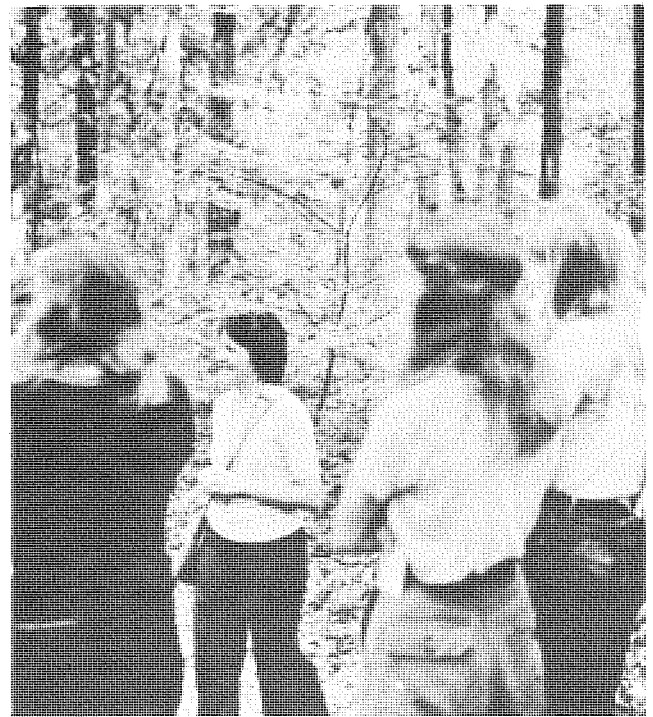

The 1976 Forestry Conclave Team, under the close supervision of F. Dominic Dottavio, travelled to a snowy Houghton, Michigan October 15th to compete in the 25th Annual Midwestern Conclave. Placing 5th overall out of a field of 12 very competitive teams, the Boilermakers brought home 2 firsts, 1 third and 1 fourth.

Chuck Monogue led the team off to a good start early Saturday morning, October 16th, by teaching the other participants how to toss a log in the Bolt Throw. He accomplished the winning distance of sixteen feet and eight inches even with the disadvantage of an extremely large bolt (supplied graciously by the hosts, Michigan Tech).

The Special Event, relay style, was taken away by Purdue. After the disqualification of all the other teams one-by-one on the second leg, the Purdue foresters had all the time they wanted to take in order to finish. So, on the first leg, Tom Paulsen decided to play a new game, "Who Can Take the Most Time to Figure a Simple Surveying Problem?" (Sorry, Uncle Don.) Tom won, hands down. After forty-five minutes and many wrong, but very close answers, he finally got his answer approved much to the delight of the cheering Purdue fans, who were missing their supper.

Not to be outdone, Roger Schmidt took over the second leg, setting another record for the longest time to chop down an eight inch pine tree. But as it finally fell within the rigid boundary specifications of 20° that every other team had missed, a shot rang out that was heard all over Lake Gitchigoomie. Tom Berry and Chuck Monogue then proceeded to chop the log into four equal pieces, and meticulously stack the pieces to meet the requirements of the judges, who unanimously agreed that Purdue was the winner, and that it was also one hour past their suppertime.

PURDUE HOSTS WILDLIFE CONCLAVE

After twelve months of preparation, consultation, anticipation, and frustration, the Purdue Wildlife Club was put to the test: could we successfully host the Seventh Annual Central States Wildlife Student Conclave? The answer received from over one hundred students and faculty representing eleven Midwest Universities was a unanimous yes.

Bodies wearied from a day-long drive arrived Friday evening, March 4, in time to unpack and join the "mixer" party held at Campus Inn Motel. Later that evening, Dr. Erich Klinghammer of the North American Wildlife Park Foundation showed the movie, "Death of a Legend." A captive audience listened as he explained the nature of his studies at the Wolf Research Facility in Battleground, Indiana and answered questions about the movie.

A series of guest speakers headed off Saturday's events. Dr. Charles Kirkpatrick gave the welcoming address, followed by many distinguished professors and personnel from the Indiana Dept. of Natural Resources. The lecture sessions were designed to give visiting students an idea of Indiana's role and involvement in the field of Wildlife and Fisheries. The half hour talks covered all aspects of management and research, including: Areas of Wildlife Management in Indiana, Roadside Vegetation Management, Ectoparasites of Indiana Mammals, Fisheries in Indiana, Ecological Aspects of the Endangered Indiana Bat, and White-tail Deer Management in Indiana. Concluding statements were given by Dr. Harmon P. Weeks.

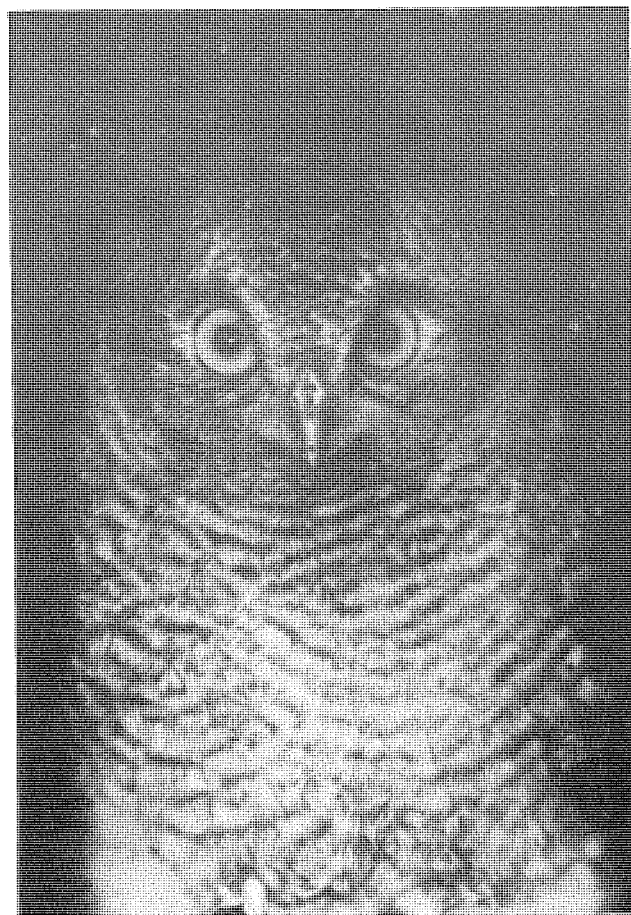
Team and school spirit were at their best during the Wildlife Quiz Bowl on Saturday afternoon. Four participants from each school competed in the single elimination contest on such subjects as: Wildlife and Fisheries Management, Taxonomy of Flora and Fauna, Anatomy and Physiology, Limnology, Entomology, General Ecological Principles, and Wildlife History, Policy, and Legislation. After nearly three hours of mind-boggling questions, the team from University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point was proclaimed the winner.

Purdue students and staff were active in donating and preparing the main course, breads, and desserts for Saturday night's Game Roast and Awards Banquet. Lucky students (those at the head of the line) were able to sample pheasant, squirrel, deer, fish, raccoon, muskrat, and rabbit from the buffet. While the delectable dishes were digesting, an engraved plaque was presented to Stevens Point students for their victory. This plaque was donated by Purdue to the Conclave, with ample space to list the winners for many years.

Six wildlife trophies (three for black and white and three for color) were presented to students who submitted their wildlife prints in the second annual Photography Contest. All photos were on display throughout the day, and were judged by Dr. Russell Mumford and Howard Knaus. Saturday night's activities continued with music provided for dancing and listening pleasure by the group, "Bandana."

Those who stayed up late on Saturday night regretted it as they boarded the buses for field trips bright and early Sunday morning. Students had a choice of one of three field trips to Jasper-Pulaski State Fish and Game Area, Willow Slough State Fish and Game Area, or a joint trip to the Wolf Research Farm and the Purdue Wildlife Area. They received a tour of the areas, an explanation of the types of management and/or research, and answers to any questions about wildlife practices.

A feeling of satisfaction and accomplishment came to all those who worked on the Conclave as they received the best of compliments from departing students. A good impression of Purdue and Indiana will be taken with them to their respective schools and remembered for years to come.

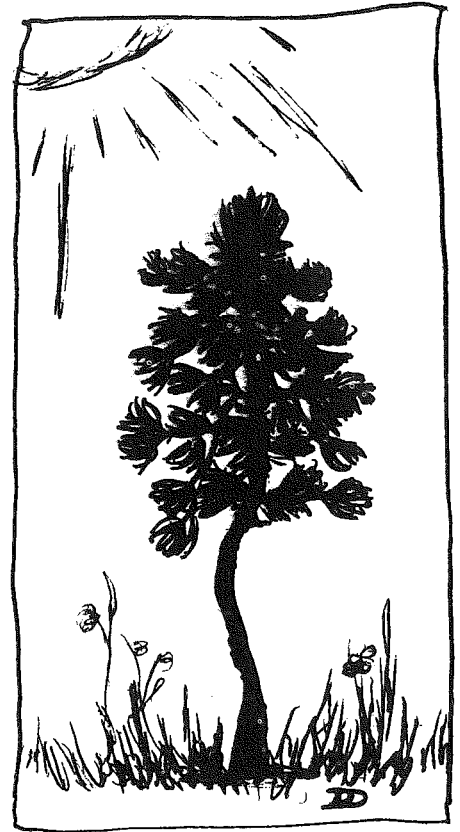

Bent Pine

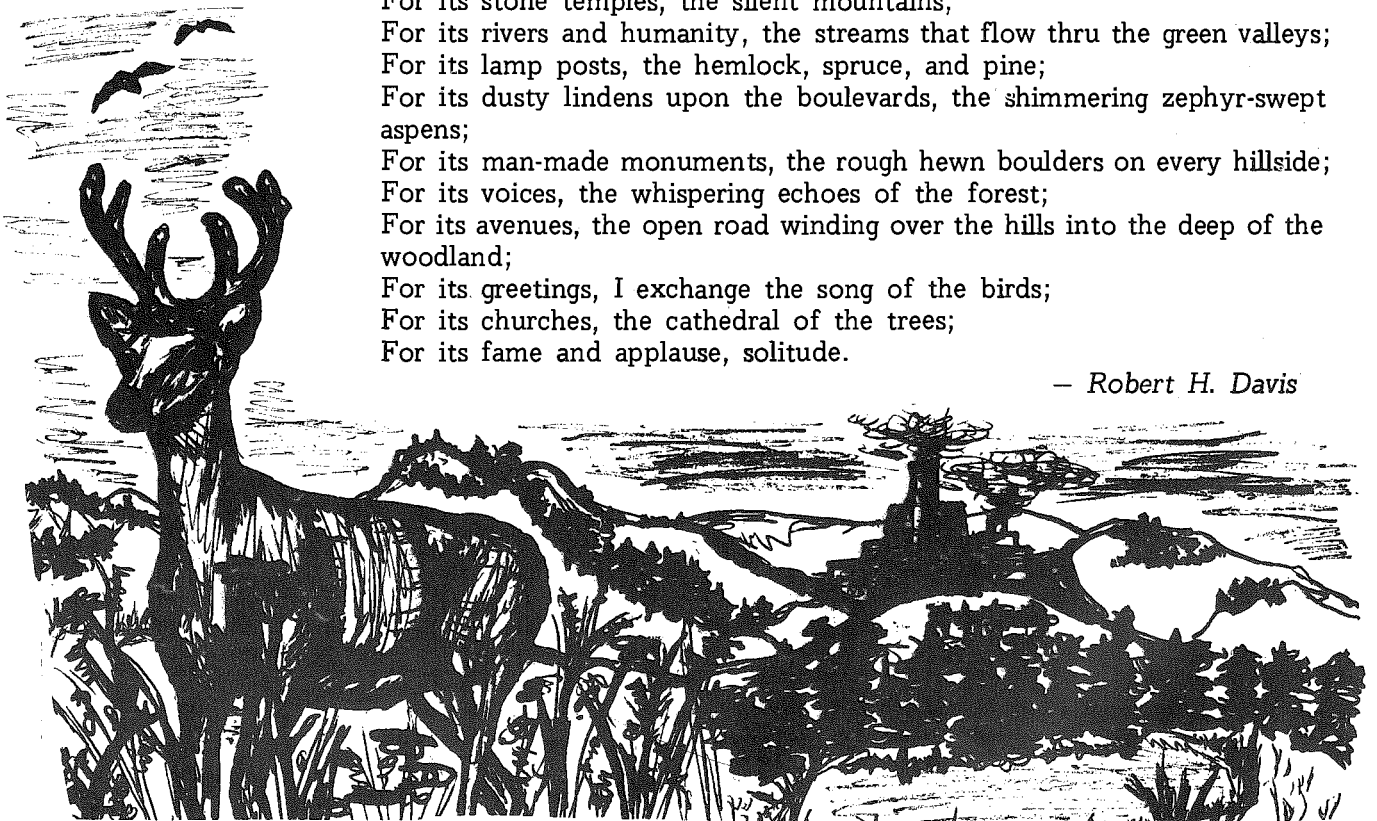
One spring my father showed me

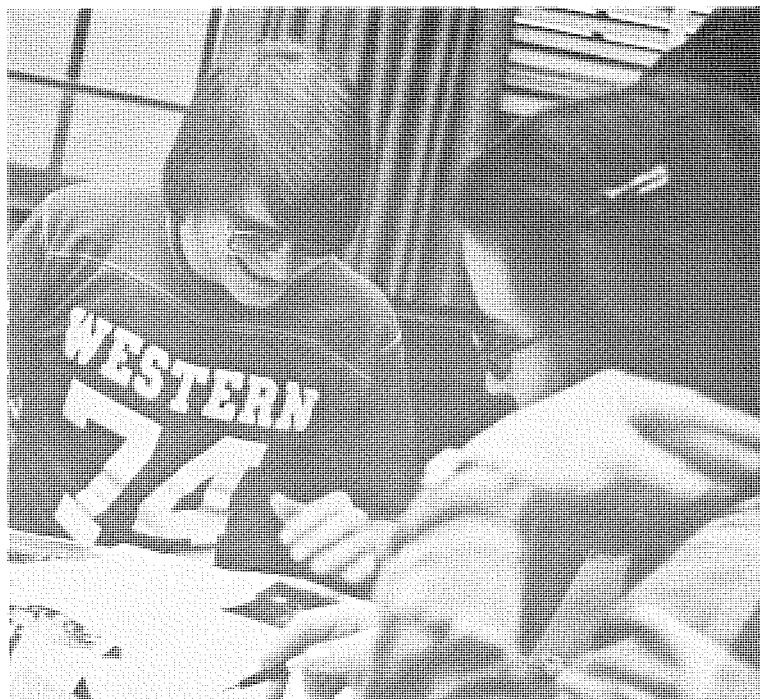
