Criteria

Declared Major: Agriculture Related, Business/Economics Related, Any Engineering

Classification: Collegiate Freshman or first-year student at a university

Targeted Recipients:

- Member of a MANRRS collegiate organization
- Any Person within Minority Status

- Grade Point Average: 3.0 Cumulative or above

Required Documentation

1. Submit a resume demonstrating academic excellence, leadership record, community and extracurricular activities.
2. Submit official transcript showing GPA of 3.0 or higher and classification.
3. Three letters of recommendation- (including one letter from your MANRRS Advisor)
4. Submit one-page essay on one of the below topics:
 - *John Deere's higher purpose is a **Commitment to Serving those Linked to the Land**. Please describe how you connect with this higher purpose and how it inspires your education and career ambitions.*
 - John Deere's core values are **Integrity, Quality, Commitment, and Innovation**. Please describe how you embody these core values.
 - With the current uncertainty and volatility in the agriculture industry, please describe what makes you passionate about joining the agriculture industry?

Selection Process

1. John Deere will review and select students based on the above criteria.
