

Undergraduate Scholarships

SCHOLARSHIPS: NAICC's Foundation for Environmental Agriculture Education (FEAE) will provide three Undergraduate Scholarships to be awarded to deserving Undergraduate students in agriculture.

- RICHARD JENSEN SCHOLARSHIP: \$3,000
 - A \$3,000 scholarship known as the Richard Jensen Scholarship. It commemorates one of the early members of the National Alliance of Independent Crop Consultants.
- Two BELCHIM CROP PROTECTION SCHOLARSHIPS: \$1,500 each
 - \$1,500 scholarship known as the Belchim Crop Protection scholarship. This scholarship has been generously donated by Belchim Crop Protection to further help support the agriculture industry.

CRITERIA: Please review the following Undergraduate Scholarship criteria before submitting the application:

1. Pursuing a four-year degree in a major or discipline closely aligned to crop production, such as Soil Science, Agronomy, Entomology, Horticulture, Plant Pathology, Weed Science, or Crop Science.
2. Completed a minimum of one year toward a four-year degree.

Graduate Scholarships

SCHOLARSHIPS: Two Graduate Scholarships will be awarded to Graduate students in agriculture:

- EDWARD H. LLOYD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: \$3,000
 - Edward H. Lloyd Memorial Graduate Scholarship has been funded for \$3,000 in remembrance of Edward H. Lloyd who was a founding member of the NAICC.
- WILBUR ELLIS SCHOLARSHIP: \$2,000
 - Wilbur Ellis Graduate Scholarship sponsored for \$2,000 by Wilbur Ellis to help support the agriculture industry.

CRITERIA: Please review the following Graduate Scholarship criteria before submitting the application:

1. Pursuing a graduate degree in a major or discipline closely aligned to crop production, such as Soil Science, Agronomy, Entomology, Horticulture, Plant Pathology, Weed Science, or Crop Science.
2. Completed an undergraduate degree.
