

Text from the Vice Provost's letter:

“The Provost’s Program for Instructional Innovation seeks to encourage new and innovative instructional initiatives by providing funding for equipment. Funding will be allocation on a competitive basis to support the undergraduate curricular changes in need of new equipment or technology or to establish new undergraduate curricula with unique equipment needs.

Funding priority will be given to innovative instructional approaches and to interdisciplinary projects. Each college/school may submit up to three proposals in priority rand order Request can be at any level up to a usual maximum of \$70,000. Although not required, any college/school leverage funding should be reported. We anticipate funding three to five proposals this year.

Each submission should include a two to three page proposal describing the project and the potential impact on undergraduate instruction.”
