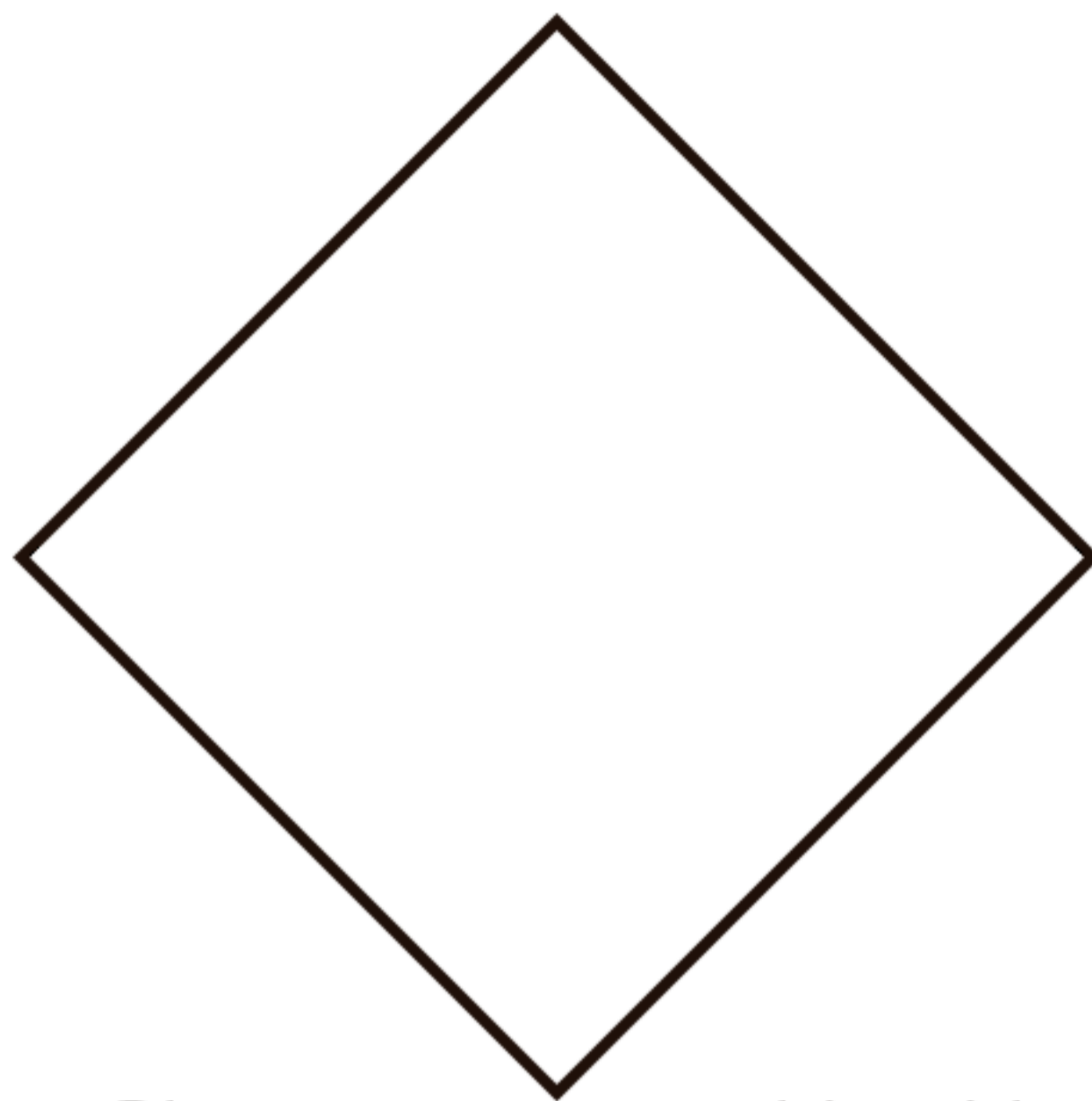


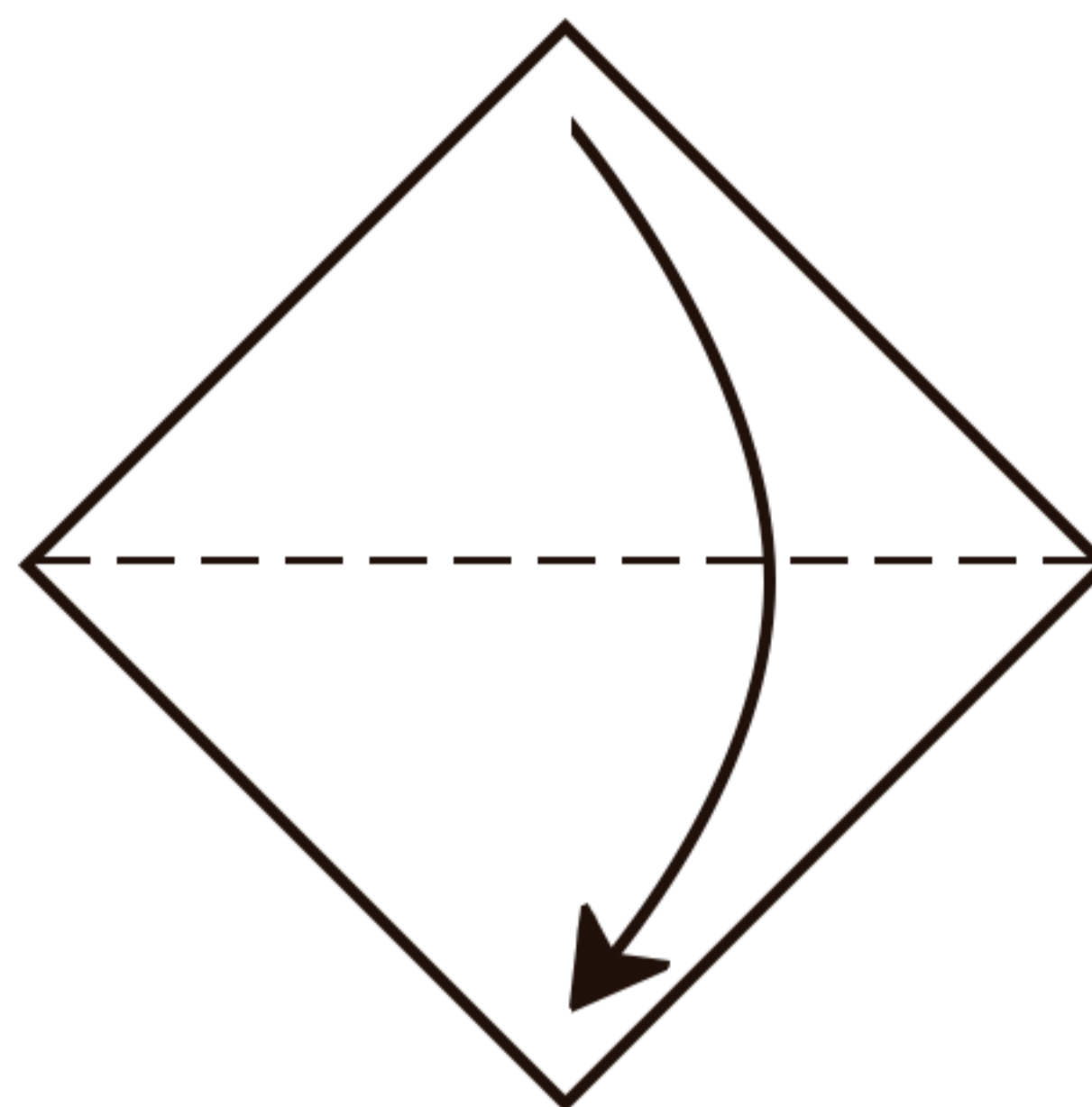
Spotted Lanternfly Origami Instructions

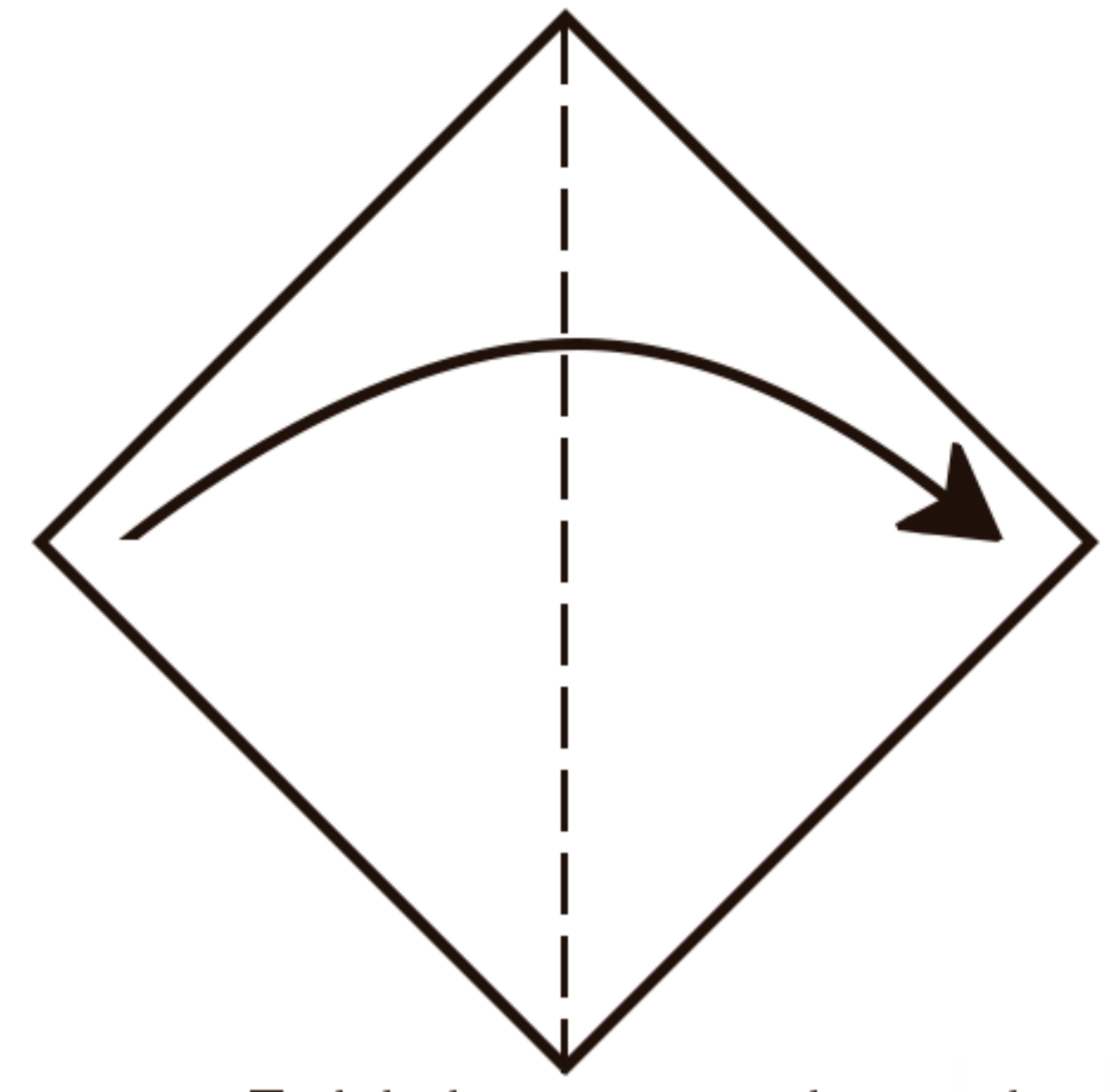

1. Place your paper white side up. The orientation of the pattern doesn't matter for steps 1-3.

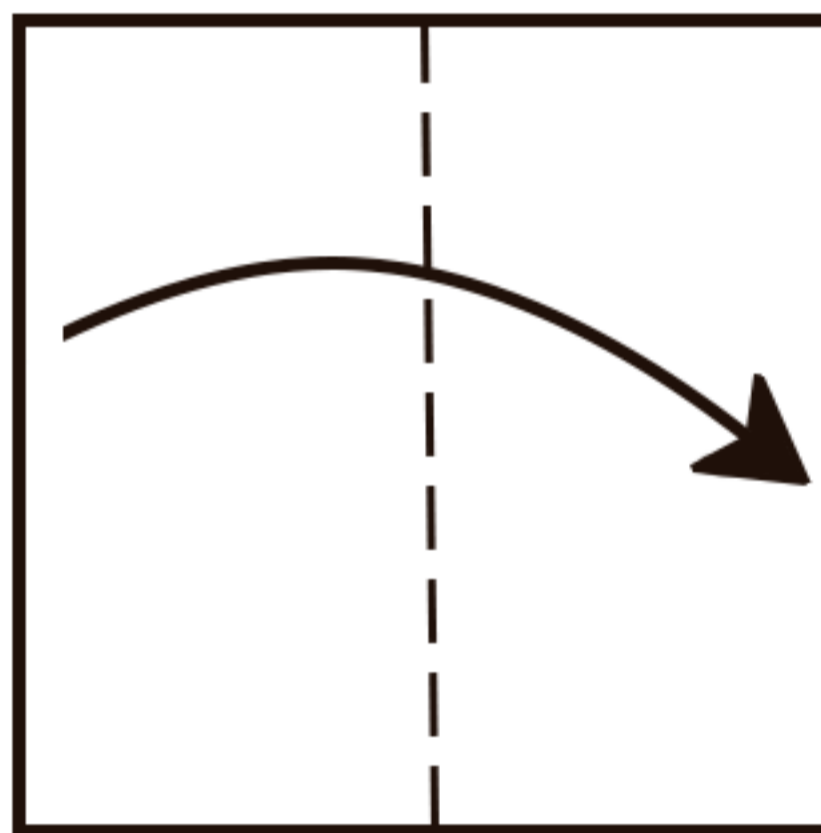


2. Fold the paper in half at a diagonal and unfold.

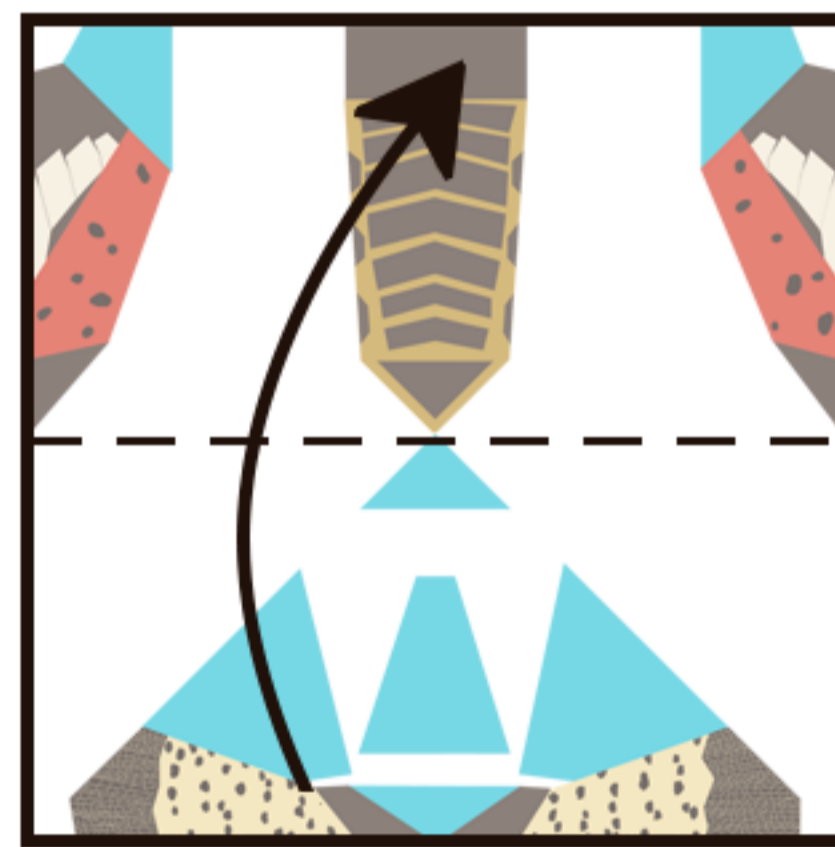


3. Fold the paper along the opposite diagonal. Unfold.

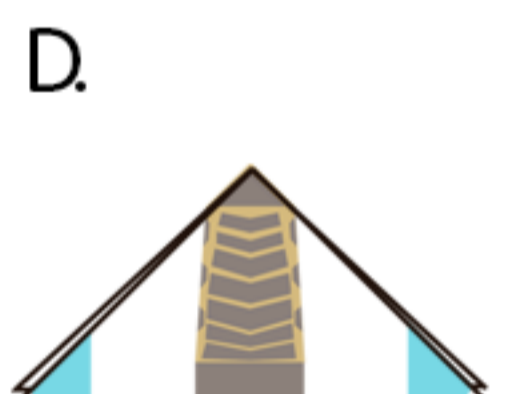
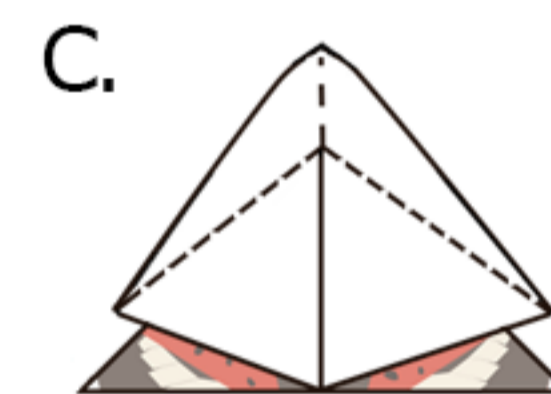
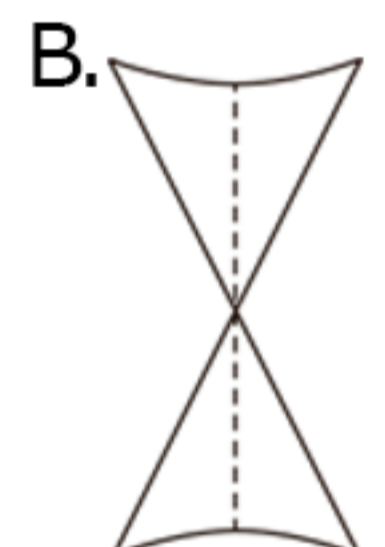
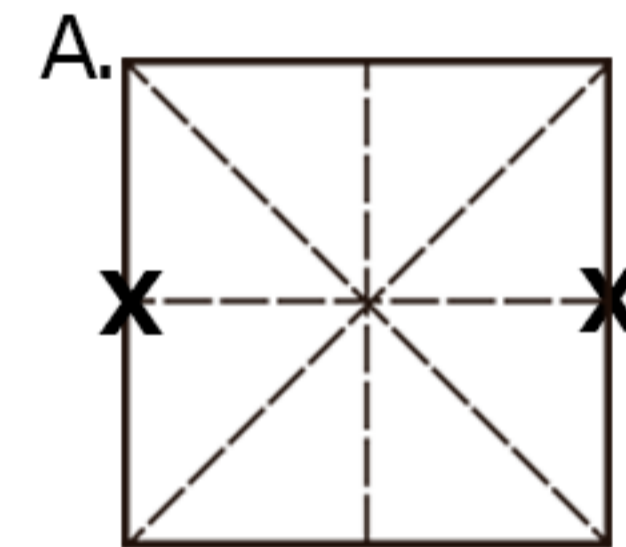
The paper should be placed in this direction.



4. Fold the paper in half. Unfold.



5. Flip the paper image side up. Fold the paper in half. Unfold.



6. **A.** Flip the paper so the white side is up. Pinch one X with each hand. **B.** Push the Xs together. **C.** Flatten the bottom section. **D.** Flatten the top section.



7. Rotate so that the blue corners are on tip and the brown triangle is close to you. The final shape and printed image should look like this.



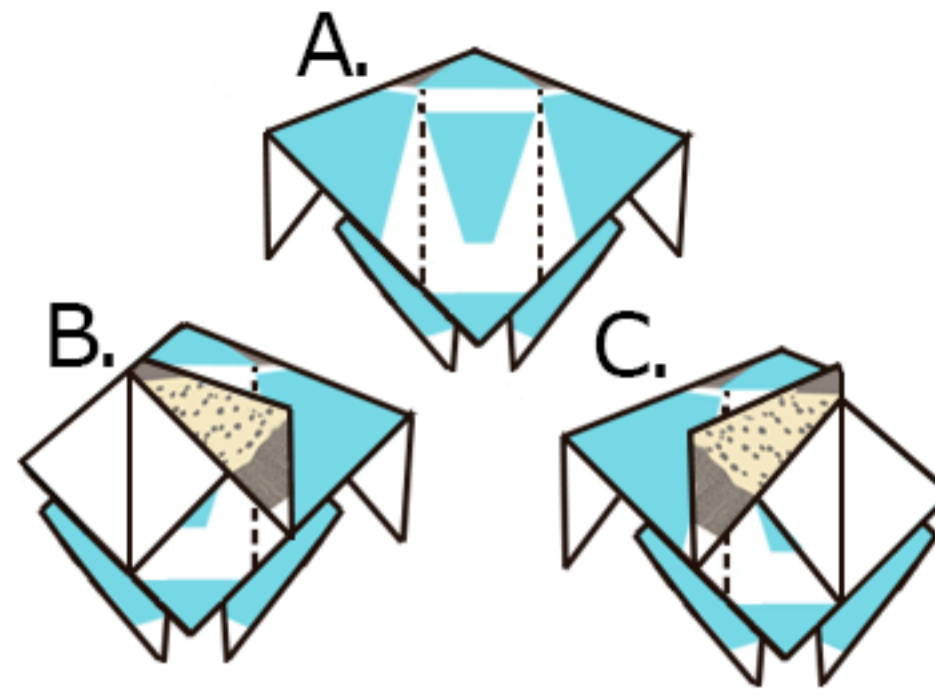
8. Fold the paper along the dotted line (labeled 8). The dotted line is hidden behind the blue shape that says "Purdue". Repeat on both sides.



9. It should look like this now.



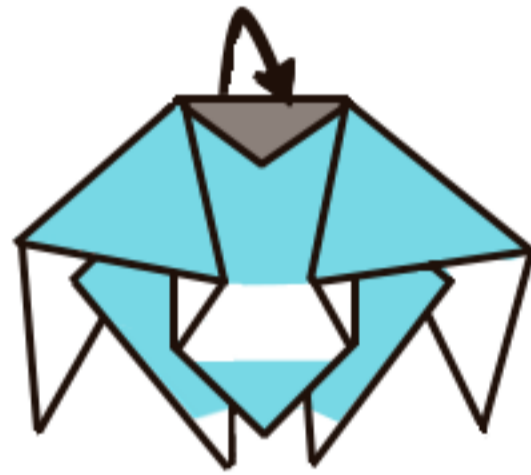
10. Fold the paper along the dotted line (labeled 10) between the light brown spotted wings and the blue/white paper. Repeat on both sides.



11. A. Flip the paper over.
B. Fold the wing across the body along the dotted lines (labeled 11) and UNFOLD. Only fold the top layer of paper. You shouldn't see the pink wing.
C. Repeat on the other side.



12. Fold the blue shapes so that line 12a matches with 12a and 12b matches with 12b. Only fold the top layer. Flatten out.



13. Fold the top triangle (head) down along the bottom of the white line (labeled 13).



14. Fold the head up along the top of the white line (labeled 14).



15. Repeat steps 13-14 with the bottom triangle. Fold along the black lines.



16. Flip over. If the brown wings are behind the pink wings, adjust them so that the brown wings are on top. Crease the tips of the wings where the white triangle meets the pattern.



17. Flip the white triangles inside the wings so they are no longer visible.

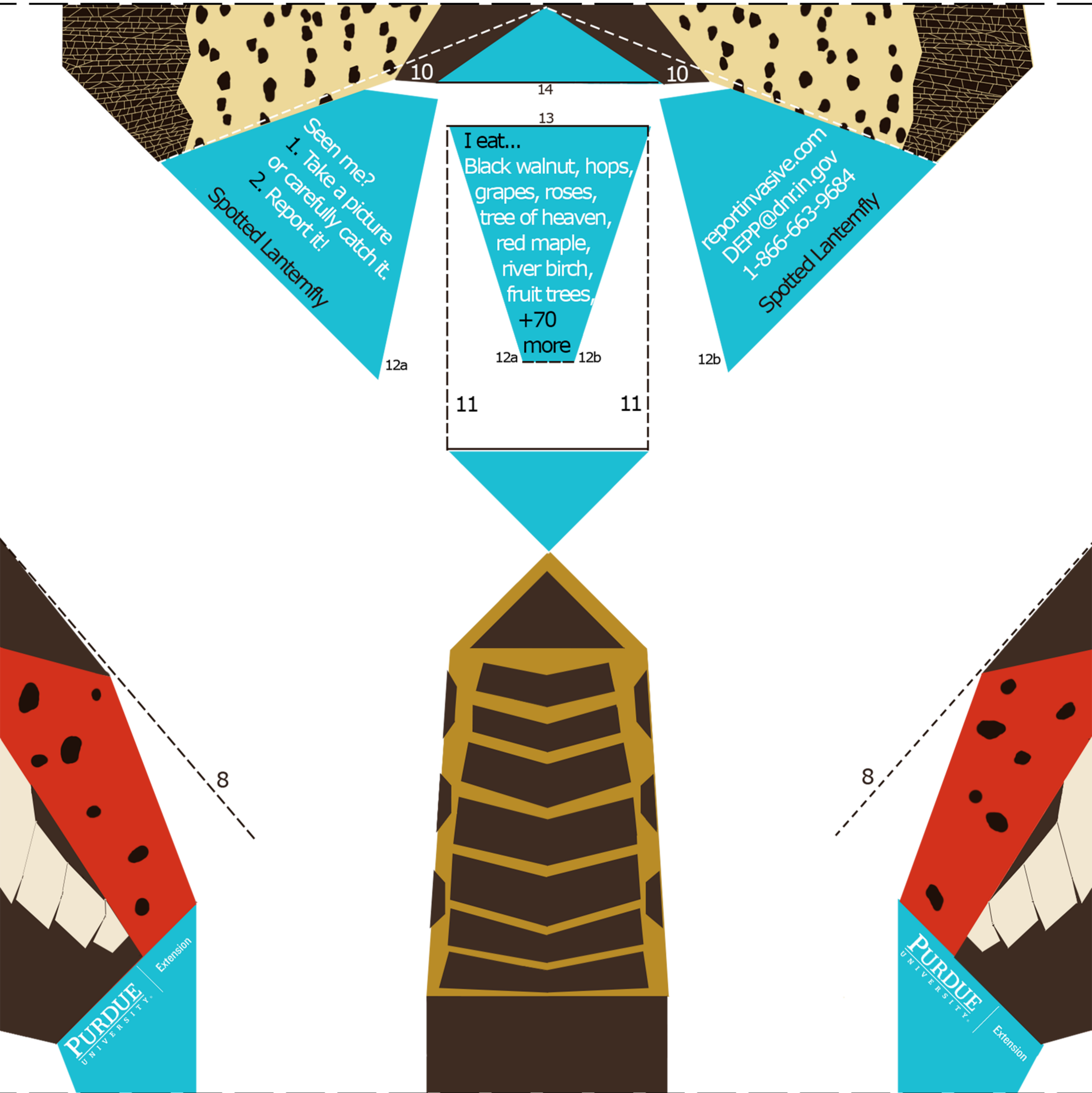


18. You're finished! Enjoy and remember: if you see a live spotted lanternfly, report it!
