ARMS II & Chemical Use Adjuvants

An adjuvant is a chemical added to a pesticide to increase its effectiveness or safety. Adjuvants include such materials as wetting agents, spreaders, emulsifiers, dispersing agents, foaming agents, foam suppressants, and penetrants.

Adjuvants should be **excluded** from the table in Section D.

However, if you or the respondent are in doubt about whether a product should be included in Section D, record it anyway and write notes to explain the situation.
