How will the data be used?

This survey will provide information regarding updated potential yields for corn and soybeans. Although you may have completed surveys like this for the last few months, each new survey allows us to measure changes from the last month related to current growing conditions in our region.

If we do not hear from you by Saturday, October 29, 2022, we may attempt to contact you to arrange a telephone interview. Additionally, with the short time frame for data collection there is a chance that we may call before you have had the opportunity to respond by mail or online. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in this very important project.

The information you provide will be used for statistical purposes only. In accordance with federal law, your responses will be kept confidential and will not be disclosed in identifiable form. We will publish the survey findings in the November *Crop Production* report, to be released on Wednesday, November 09, 2022.
