The Cherry Forecast is needed by the Cherry Industry Administrative Board in order to help evaluate the 2025 supply and determine whether diversion of Tart Cherries is necessary. Thecherry industry is incredibly important to our state's agricultural economy and accurate statistics help producers deal with production and marketing challenges.
