Why am I getting this letter?

Enclosed is your 2024 April Quarterly Colony Loss survey. Your participation is important. As one of only 3,500 beekeepers receiving this survey, your response is vital to ensure that accurate data about your industry are available. Please complete and return the questionnaire at your earliest convenience.

You may receive an email reminder. If we do not receive your completed questionnaire by **March 31**, we may contact you for an interview.

How will the data be used?

The data can be used by beekeepers and other interested parties to analyze data on a state-by-state basis and compare specific quarterly losses, additions, and movements. It also provides a statistical benchmark on honey bee colony numbers and death loss for comparison on an annual and quarterly basis.

We recommend that you respond online. On the Respondent Portal, you can complete your survey, track upcoming surveys, access data visualizations and reports of interest, link to other USDA agencies, and more.

The information you provide will be used for statistical purposes only. **In accordance with federal law, your responses will be kept confidential and will not be disclosed in identifiable form**. We will publish the data August 1, 2024, in the *Honey Bee Colonies* report at <u>nass.usda.gov</u>.
