We recommend you respond online using the Respondent Portal. On the portal, you can complete your surveys, track upcoming surveys, access data visualizations and reports of interest, link to other USDA agencies, and more.

The information you provide will be used for statistical purposes only. **In accordance with federal law, your responses will be kept confidential and will not be disclosed in identifiable form**. We will publish the data Tuesday, April 22, 2025, in the *Milk Production* report at <u>nass.usda.gov/publications</u> and in NASS's searchable database, Quick Stats, at <u>quickstats.nass.usda.gov</u>.


