As one of only 3,500 beekeepers receiving this survey, your response is vital to ensure accurate data about your industry are available.

You may receive an email reminder to complete your questionnaire. If we do not receive your completed questionnaire by Monday, **March 31**, we may contact you for an interview.

Data from this survey will:

- Allow beekeepers, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and other interested parties to analyze data on a state-by-state basis and compare specific quarterly losses, additions, and movements.
- Provide a statistical benchmark on honey bee colony numbers and death loss for comparison on an annual and quarterly basis.

We recommend you respond online at <u>agcounts.usda.gov</u>. You can complete your surveys, track upcoming surveys, access data visualizations and reports of interest, link to other USDA agencies, and more.

The information you provide will be used for statistical purposes only. In accordance with federal law, your responses will be kept confidential and will not be disclosed in identifiable form. The *Honey Bee Colonies* report will be published on August 1, 2025, at <u>nass.usda.gov</u>.
