The Vegetable Grower Inquiry will have a limited number of coordinated surveys with FCUS and ARMS2, as well as the Potato Grower Survey, Cost of Pollination, and November Ag Yield.

WHY SHOULD I REPORT?

Vegetable estimates are needed by the vegetable industry to help growers. The vegetable industry is incredibly important to our region's agricultural economy and grower surveys are the only way we can document how much vegetables really do count. Vegetable statistics are used by everyone in the industry to help serve the farmer by getting grant money, farm bill representation, and extension coverage.

FSA's non-insured crop disaster assistance program (NAP) utilizes the estimates derived from this survey to pay growers for crop losses that are not covered by insurance. Without this survey, NAP payments could be calculated based on the lower price of those processed vegetables from across the country.
