ARMS III - Erickson

The data collection period for ARMS III ends on April 16. The last day to UPS completed ARMS III questionnaires (with data) to NPC is April 18. April 18 is also the last day to submit all other ARMS III records. These include out-of-business records, refusals, and inaccessibles.

The reason for the 2-day gap between the last day to work and the last day to UPS completed questionnaires to NPC is to allow a little time for you (or your Supervisor) to review completes before they are sent to NPC. Please send completes with data to NPC on a timely basis. It takes time for NPC to check in records, and to key & load the data.

Please submit refusals as you get them. Also, please feel free to submit inaccessibles on April 16 & 17. Our sample size is over 3,000 so please make sure you account for all records by the specified dates.


Do not send any ARMS III questionnaires to the GLR office. All ARMS III records are to be sent via UPS to NPC (if it is a complete with data) or submitted on the iPad (if it is out-of-business, refusal, or inaccessible).

For every record submitted on CAPI, PLEASE enter a comment. A simple comment such as 'refusal, did not want to provide financial data' or 'unable to make contact with operator', is good enough.

NASS Discontinued 2024 Data Collection Programs and Reports - Kalaus

To account for the recently issued FY 2024 appropriated budget, NASS has reviewed its operations to find efficiencies and cost savings. As a result, NASS is canceling the July Cattle report and discontinuing the Cotton Objective Yield Survey, as well as all County Estimates for Crops and Livestock beginning with the 2024 production year.

The decision to discontinue these surveys and reports was not made lightly, but was necessary, given appropriated budget levels. NASS has and will continue to review its estimating programs using criteria focused on the needs of its mission and customers to prioritize budget decisions.

Avian Influenza - Collom

The Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus has been found in our region in both commercial poultry flocks and, for the first time, in cattle. HPAI has led to the rapid depopulation of a large number of commercial layers in Michigan in recent weeks. The primary vectors for HPAI are native migratory bird populations, however NASDA enumerators must remain vigilant in their bio-security practices and procedures. Do not be the person who carries disease from one farm to the next.

The National Milk Producers Federation (NMPF) maintains a website dedicated to AI management for cattle operations: <u>HPAI Resources - NMPF</u>

NASDA enumerators should:

- Rather than visiting in person, enumerators should first attempt to phone operations with commercial poultry flocks or cattle
- If visiting farms in person, park in a clean area, away from livestock

- Keep away from livestock (at least 6 feet), which means never touching any livestock
- Do not enter areas of a farm where livestock are known to be present unless invited there by a farmer
- Use boot sanitizer if the farm makes it available
- Wash or sanitize your hands between farm visits
- Offer to use disposable protective boot covers if you'll be on a farm with commercial poultry or cattle.

The office maintains a supply of protective boot covers. These can be requested through the "NASDA Order Form" on the NASDA/Purdue website.

June Area Pre-Screening- Goings and Laird

The last day for Pre-Screening is approaching. Enumeration ends on April 16th and the last day to submit data into CAPI is April 18th. Please work on submitting your data into CAPI this weekend. Remember that you should submit your tracts far enough in the system that they should at least be saved for review. A progress report will be run on Monday and supervisors will be notified of their teams' progress by the end of the day.
