Soybean Form B: Items 14 – 16 are new this year.
Harvested pods from all plants in the <u>3-foot section</u> of unit 1 must be counted. Unit 2 may be used if there are no plants in the 3-foot section of Unit 1.

The GLR is the only region doing this.

Counts within the 6-inch area remain unchanged.

Harvest procedures remain unchanged.

• Lab procedures remain unchanged. The lab in St. Louis will continue to count the pods sent for harvested units.

 The item 15 count could be several hundred. The item 16 count will likely be very low.



 Form-B data collection (counts) may not begin until August 25 (for the September 1 Survey). However, once the Form-A is completed and you have permission to enter the field, you may find and set up the sample plots.

• It takes much longer to make Form-B counts when the unit must also be set up, so this should help with being able to get all the samples worked the first month.



 So, to spread out the workload the first month, HQ is allowing enumerators to setup units prior to August 25.

 Please be as efficient as possible, and work with your Supervisor to develop a strategy.

 Remember, Form-B counts can't be made prior to August 25.



Setting up units prior to August 25 is not required.

 Row space measurements can be made when setting up the units prior to August 25. However, DO NOT go past item 5 on the Form-B. Remember, Form-B counts can't be made prior to August 25.

• When you re-visit the units to make counts, the unit location code should be '1', since it is the first Form-B submitted for this sample.



 If the units for a sample are setup early, the date on the Form-B will be the date that counts were made, not the date the unit was setup.

 The Form-B date that counts were made will be the date used in CAPI (fieldwork date).
