CAPI: Overview

- Form A and B are recorded on paper.
- CAPI data entry should be done after the interview and/or fieldwork is complete.
- Enumerators should **NEVER take iPads into fields.**
- CAPI Form A available after CAPI start date is reached. It will close on November 1.
- CAPI Form B available from the 1st day of data collection through at least the first of the month.

CAPI: Reminders

- Hold forms completed outside CAPI open & close dates until the next survey period opens for entering data
- Hold on to paper forms through the survey period for reference. Do NOT send any Form A's or Form B's to the RFO or NOD
- Seq. number = Sample number
- Multi-sampled operations (same target POID) are starred in the assignment listing (works the same for FORM A or B)



CAPI: Form A Highlights

- FORM A is extremely trimmed down to capture only the data needed for the SPS edit
- Field Selection Table A not available in CAPI
- Take the time to review FORM A in CAPI Training before live data entry begins



CAPI: Form B Highlights

- CAPI Form B designed to follow the paper, but differences will exist.
 - Example: instructional text irrelevant to Form B data entry is left out
- Take the time to review FORM B in CAPI Training before live data entry begins
