CEAP Status and Request for Shipment of Completed Forms - Bradley-Trietsch/Laird

We are approaching the end of data collection for CEAP but there are still a lot of forms in the field that need to be shipped to the NOD.

We wanted to share our current progress compared to the rest of the US. We are currently in the bottom 3 regions (10th out of 12) for return rates to the NOD at this point at 27% of forms returned. This is compared to a US return rate of 36% as seen in the screenshot below. MI is leading the region at 45% mailed in, followed by Ohio at 24% and Indiana at 18%. We are aware that there are some enumerators that have shipped 0 forms to the NOD which is unfortunately problematic at this point in the project.

We are asking all enumerators to ship their completed CEAP forms (that includes ALL forms, complete, refusals, inaccessible, out of scope, etc) to the NOD as soon as possible so that we have sufficient time in the office to process them in our computer edits. Also, please remember to mark forms as complete in CAPI.

The last day for data collection is 2/26 and the final day to UPS forms to the NOD is 2/27. 

TOTAL Landlord Only Questionnaires & Processing - Magen/Courser

The Total Landlord Only Questionnaires were sent in the March 1 Survey packets on Thursday, February 20. A few points to keep in mind as you begin enumeration:

- These operators should be landowners, renting or leasing land to others as part of a farm operation, but do not operate their own farm or ranch.
- These are operations who do not have a valid phone number, so a field visit will likely be necessary. If you can find a valid phone number, you can call to complete the survey.
- For operations with a *PO BOX Address*, additional research was done to find an updated address/phone number or possible new contact. This will be located on an additional label on the questionnaire (see imagine below).

<u>IMPORTANT:</u> The completed TOTAL (Landlord Only) surveys should be submitted through CAPI. This is different from the ARMS3 TOTAL Version. The labeled questionnaires you have been provided are to help with data collection, but do not need to be returned by mail.



Enumerator UPS Packages Shipped - Laird

Enumerator packages containing information for March surveys were sent via UPS on Thursday, February 20. Enumerators expecting work should receive their package no later than Monday, February 24. CEAP Mail All Forms to the NOD by February 27 – Bradley-Trietsch

The data collection period for CEAP ends on February 26. The last day to UPS completed questionnaires (including refusals and inaccessibles) to the National Operations Division (NOD) is February 27.

The 1-day gap between the last day of data collection and the last day to UPS is to allow time for you (or your supervisor) to review completes before they get shipped. NRCS will be reviewing notes on inaccessibles and refusals, so please include a short comment for these records. Contact notes and/or a simple comment like "operator cancelled appt - refusal" is sufficient. Please submit the response code (complete, refusal, inaccessible) for all completed records in CAPI, as well.
