The Christmas Day Holiday is celebrated annually in the United States on December 25th. It first became a federal holiday in 1870 and was included as part of the four initial federal holidays passed into law, including New Year's Day, Independence Day, Thanksgiving Day, and of course, Christmas Day. Many states at the time already recognized the holiday on their own as state holidays. Initially these were unpaid holidays only for federal employees working in the District of Columbia. It wasn't until 1885 when Congress extended federal holidays to all federal employees in the nation.
