■ BAT Updates - Katherine

- Doing well with performance evaluations!
 - If 'EE pending acknowledgement' then enumerator needs to finalize their evaluation
 - If 'in-progress' then you as the supervisor need to save/finalize evaluations
 - If you have set a 'review date' in the past (that is prior to the current date), that can cause issues as well
 - Check 'pop up' settings if unable to finalize evaluations- need to allow pop ups if using a personal computer and if the settings are not correct to allow pop-ups it will not process correctly

- Timeline of large survey projects -
- Now:
 - November 1 Survey Materials shipped via UPS on Thursday 10/18 this week.
 - Potato Acreage and Disposition, Vegetable Chemical Use Survey, Cost of Pollination, Vegetable Grower Inquiry
 - QCL, ARMS II, Labor, OY are all underway. Refer to Purdue site and CAPI listings for details
 - ARMS II/VCUS Mini Schools wrapping up
 - VCUS assignments will be pushed out to CAPI as soon as packets are out the door
 - Only a few ARMS II records turned in so far, please submit at least one report per enum when able.
 - Chemical database system coming online for ARMS II/VCUS this week should be able to get new codes for new chemicals starting this week
 - Return aerial photographs to the office, use the same box it was shipped in. If you need labels, let us know.
 - Objective Yield final harvest (and gleanings if you have them) this month for many of the remaining samples
 - Will be pushing out field assignments today 10/16 to verify, not much should change

Deputy Updates - Deputies

- Can't say it enough, we appreciate all the work
 - Sep Crops APS response rate just under 60%, similar to last year
 - March and June response rates both 1% over prior year
 - Sep Hogs usable rate ~76% highest since 2017
 - Coverage of hog inventory was over ~95%
 - OY surveys usable rate for corn and soy was down ~8 points from PY, but higher than 2021 and 2022. Hovering near normal levels.
 - AY usable complete rates over 70%
 - OH was one report away from 80% complete for AY!
 - Census of Horticulture
 - Every 5 years
 - Sample size ~ 5,500
 - TOTAL
 - Every 10 years
 - Mandatory (like census)
 - ~2,800 samples
