- **Survey Updates** - Adam/Mike

- Timeline of large survey projects - similar to last month, will be brief
- Now
 - CEAP (CONSERVATION EFFECTS ASSESSMENT PROJECT)
 - Screening ongoing
 - In order to track progress completing your assignments for the CEAP survey, all

records completed in the CEAP Screening App should also be submitted in CAPI. This includes eligible and ineligible (i.e., inaccessible, refusals, and no item of interest) records.

- We can unlock points that are 'checked out' in the NRI screening site by other enumerators, but that will erase any saved data - if another enumerator has it 'checked out', and they don't save and check it in themselves, we need to make sure any changes will be saved
- NRI points can be locked if checked out on one machine vs another machine - example iPad vs home computer
- CPAMS, Crops APS, Hogs, Turkeys Raised data collection starts soon
- Soon
 - ARMS II - Oct 1.
 - Winter Wheat this year - MI and OH
 - No ARMS I data collection, expect higher OOS rates in ARMS II and ARMS III
 - Will provide train the trainer on **September 25th @ 10:00 AM-12:00**. **We will be moving the September 18th NASDA Supervisor meeting to September 25th** to accommodate the September Survey Final Data Summary on 9/18.
 - Veg Chem Year, all 3 states. - Oct 1.
 - Will provide some VCUS training during ARMS II training in **September 25th @ 10:00 AM-12:00**
 - **Mini-Schools** for ARMS II and VCUS will be between **September 26 - October 12(ish)**
- Later:
 - CEAP Phase II
 - In Person training school
 - **November 13-15** in or around the ~~Fort Wayne, Indiana area~~ **Perrysburg OH (just outside of Toledo)**
 - Working on final touches in the contract now
 - We will have Supervisors come in the **night before (on the 12th)** and we will have a **Supervisor Meeting at 10:00AM on the 13th** in the meeting space in the Hilton Garden Inn
 - All enumerators will drive to the hotel on **Wed., November 13th** and we will **start the CEAP-Phase 2 training at 1:00PM**
 - The training school will **end around NOON on November 15th**.
 - We will be using two hotels (that are right next to each other) and split rooms accordingly

 - ◆ Home 2 Suites (Hilton)
 - ◆ Both in Perrysburg, OH
 - All enumerators working on CEAP should plan to attend
 - Dec 1, Tenure Ownership and Transition of Agricultural Land. (T.O.T.A.L.) and Census of Horticulture later this year
